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01 / DEFINE THE DECISION

Date / visit window**My regular lake activity**

Choose the outing you intend to repeat, not just try once.

Entrance and shore

Name the public entry and mark the route from the front door.

Useful crossing

Record the crossing that connects your home to a recurring destination.

Short loop and longer outing

Sketch two routes that fit different amounts of free time.

Fill digitally or print. Keep passwords, identity numbers and account details elsewhere.

02 / INVESTIGATE THE TRADEOFFS

From idea to evidence.

Use dates, exact addresses and observed conditions. A missing answer is a useful follow-up, not a reason to guess.

Building-to-trail steps

Record exits, elevators, stairs and equipment collection.

Unit-specific observations

Note sound, orientation and usable outdoor space during your visit.

Non-trail destination

Test a grocery or appointment trip and the return journey.

Closure alternative

Describe the route you would use if your usual segment were unavailable.

Keep three things separate

What you saw / What a dated source says / What still needs confirmation

03 / CHECK, CITE & MOVE FORWARD

Bring a better brief.

Complete the checks that apply, keep the sources you used, and turn the open questions into a specific next step.

- ☐ Mark the entrance, crossing and final blocks to your destination.
- ☐ Check the trail map and current detour information.
- ☐ Test the complete route from the unit or front door.
- ☐ Confirm bicycle storage and permitted building exits.
- ☐ Observe the actual unit during your normal at-home hours.
- ☐ Keep water-recreation checks separate from property questions.

The question that could change my decision

Include the address, source or situation and the exact confirmation you need.
