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01 / DEFINE THE DECISION

California to Austin Scouting & Arrival Sheet

Connect your scouting results to the shipment, housing access and official arrival tasks.

Date / visit window**Scouting questions to resolve**

List what requires an actual-property visit or route rehearsal.

California work hours in Austin

Map recurring meetings onto your local day and workspace needs.

First-home commitment

Record lease or purchase timing and the terms still awaiting confirmation.

Shipment assumptions

List inventory, stairs, elevators and the quoted delivery window.

Fill digitally or print. Keep passwords, identity numbers and account details elsewhere.

02 / INVESTIGATE THE TRADEOFFS

From idea to evidence.

Use dates, exact addresses and observed conditions. A missing answer is a useful follow-up, not a reason to guess.

Destination access contact

Record who confirms loading, keys and arrival instructions.

Departure and arrival records

Attach official DMV/DPS links and your applicable tasks and deadlines.

Service activation sequence

Record provider, confirmed start date and installation dependencies.

Delayed-arrival fallback

Choose first-night accommodation and essentials kept outside the shipment.

Keep three things separate

What you saw / What a dated source says / What still needs confirmation

03 / CHECK, CITE & MOVE FORWARD

Bring a better brief.

Complete the checks that apply, keep the sources you used, and turn the open questions into a specific next step.

- ☐ Schedule actual-property tours and an ordinary errand test.
- ☐ Translate work commitments into your Austin calendar.
- ☐ Request equivalent mover estimates with the same inventory.
- ☐ Confirm loading, keys and a delayed-arrival backup.
- ☐ Use official resources for departure and new-resident tasks.
- ☐ Verify providers and service dates for the exact address.

The question that could change my decision

Include the address, source or situation and the exact confirmation you need.
